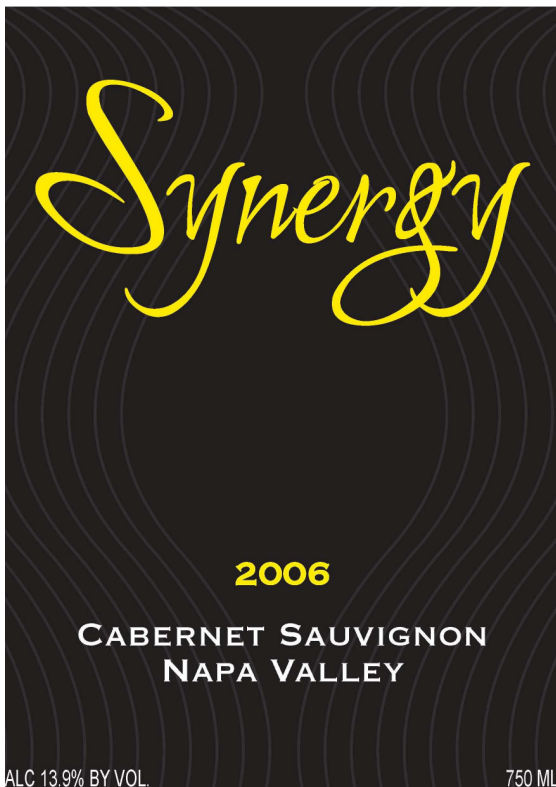

Tasting Notes

The 2006 Synergy Cabernet Sauvignon offers enticing aromatics of sweet cherries and flowery herbs, while showcasing layers of rosemary, black currant and cinnamon on the palate. The medley of flavors combined with firm, integrated oak flavors continues throughout a long, enjoyable finish.

Winemaking

The fruit was carefully selected from the finest vineyards in the Napa Valley, bin fermented and hand punched-down four times daily. Aged in French oak for 36 months the wine has excellent spicy touches and outstanding integration of flavors.
